This program is available to schools and districts that are participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs.

All enrolled students of the Harmony Area School District are eligible to receive a nutritional breakfast and lunch each school day at **no charge** to your household.

No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without paying a fee or submitting an application.
